NOTEBOOK | PAGES TO RECORD

SESSION PLAN

- » Review the main points from last week's topic—"Plan at a Glance." Have the students debrief, share their experiences and report on last week's activities. Today, we want to introduce notebook pages that can be used to learn and record new language features – a page for vocabulary, for grammar, for pronunciation and for culture.
- » Handout blank copies of each of the four recording pages, along with Veronika's completed samples. Have the students look over Veronika's samples in pairs.
- » Have the students watch the video: Notebook - Pages to Record
- » Go over each page with the whole class. For the vocabulary page, explain and do examples of connotation and collocation. With the grammar page, show students how to find grammar rules with a Google search, based on seeing the grammar form. The pronunciation page has a list of major pronunciation features. Make sure the students understand what they are.
- » Hand out the *transcript*, along with the *see it*, *try it* & *use it* activities. Have the students work through the activities. Feel free to encourage pair work. The activities that aren't completed in the session can be assigned for homework.
